Updates

- The mentoring programme commenced in October 2012 and an exploratory session was held on November 14th 2012. The exploratory session allowed us to crystallize our thinking leading to the formulation of a model described as 'mentoring 360'. In the 'mentoring 360' model employers and the participating professionals are deemed to be learners.

A mechanism is integrated to achieve:

- Mentee to multiple mentors matching/access
- Cross learning forums/events

IT support is in place to maintain communications history and identify frequently asked questions.
